RIO GRANDE CUTTHROAT TROUT
15-21 August 2011**

#2 Creek (aka Casias Creek), including tributaries from the headwaters to the fish migration barrier will be treated with CFT Legumine (Rotenone) to eliminate non-native fish. During treatment, New Mexico Department of Game and Fish and Vermejo Park Ranch employees will be creek side applying CFT Legumine. Please do not approach those working on the project, enter the water, or disturb any of the equipment being used during the above listed dates.

PRECAUTIONS

WATER TREATED WITH CFT LEGUMINE TO REMOVE FISH IS NOT HARMFUL TO HUMANS AND OTHER TERRESTRIAL ANIMALS. CFT LEGUMINE WILL BE NEUTRALIZED AT OR NEAR THE DOWNSTREAM FISH MIGRATION BARRIER.

HOWEVER:

- 1) DO NOT DISTURB ANY CONTAINER FOUND IN OR ALONG THE STREAM.**
- 2) DO NOT PICK UP OR EAT ANY DEAD FISH FOUND IN #2 CREEK (aka CASIAS CREEK) DRAINAGE**
- 3) DO NOT DRINK WATER FROM #2 CREEK (aka CASIAS CREEK)**
