The Open Gate Program benefits you by opening private and landlocked public land for your recreation, free of charge!



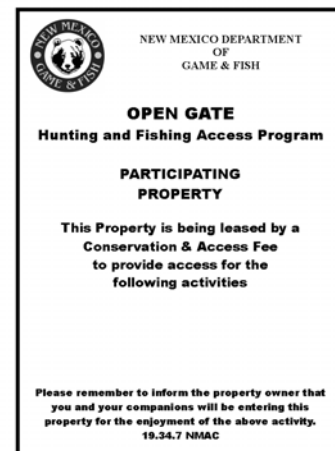
Hunters and anglers can contribute to the success of the Open Gate program by obeying all NMDGF regulations and being considerate of participating and non-participating landowners.

- Walk-In Only Unless Roads Are Designated
- Look for Open Gate Signs & Know Boundaries
- Do Not Litter
- No camping & No fires
- No Target Practice
- Do not block roads, gates, or driveways
- Respect the Landowner & the Land
